Focus on what you would like to gain more knowledge and experience in and tailor it to the individual position you are applying for. Research the company and find out what they do and what their new and important projects are and tailor it to that. Under software take out all the stuff that does not pertain to engineering they don't care is you know how to use unrelated software. Under your projects they are scattered all over the place and are obviously class assignments, did you do any internships? You have no work experience listed at all if you did any internships you should list them. Again you need to tailor the resume to the job go more into depth explaining the ones that relate to the job and leave out the rest. You are better off having fewer things listed but instead of just what the project was explain what your part in it was, what you learned and how success was measured. Be prepared to go into more detail on this when you get an interview.

I had a bunch of code then lost power so here is an abbreviated version. Im guessing that both month and day can be 1 or 2. So you will want to find where '/' occurs using substring. You can either store the length of each section or the indexes of '/'.

If you find the index of each '/' the substrings would look like

cin reads until it hits whitespace. Since there is no whitespace between the numbers it doesn't know what to do.

You will have to either read in the whole line as a string and break it into pieces or read in each character and build as you go.

You can use `cin.get()` or `cin.getline()`

Will any of the programs above get corrupted if I erase the contents of the Temp directory?
(Or any program, for that matter?)

Answer :: There are actually 2 "Temp" folders located on your pc by default.

One is found in C:\Windows\Temp

The other is found in

C:\Documents and Settings\YourUserName\Local Settings\Temp

I would not delete the one found in the windows folder. However the
C:\Documents and Settings\YourUserName\Local Settings\Temp

Is fine to delete.

The temp folder stores temporary files accessed by programs in use or that were used. Over time it can fill up, and any time you can clear it.

It will not effect your programs because any program that needs a temp file will simply recreate it.

The easiest way to clear your temporary directory is to not actually delete the folder but instead do the following:

Click "START" then "RUN" then type in %temp% and click OK.

This will open the correct temp folder, and you can simply hit ctrl+a to select everything, then delete.

Note: Some files will not delete sometimes because a program is open that is currently using it.

Another way to clear temp files is to use a program to do it for you.

The most popular one is called ccleaner. It clears temp files, and temporary internet files to speed up you pc. It is free.

Visual studio usually saves this in your documents folder under Visual Studio\<Name of your project> in that directory you should have the cpp file and the executable (.exe file) should be in the Debug folder, they might want the release version in that case you have to build it in visual studio under the dropdown list that says debug just select release and build it again and a folder named Release will be created in the same directory with the release .exe file. So just copy and paste the cpp file and exe to the desktop and you should be good. [Read More](#)
